Project summary statement:

The Fire Department owns a 1996 Emergency One Hurricane Fire Engine (J0012) with 156,950 miles.

J0012 was replaced by J0158 in 2019. Since 2019, J0012 was on loan to the Fire Training Consortium. This is a scheduled replacement due to age. The estimated surplus value is \$6,000.

A RESOLUTION declaring one 1996 Emergency One Hurricane Fire Engine (J0012) surplus and authorizing for sale at Public Auction,

WHEREAS,

1. The City has one 1996 Emergency One Hurricane Fire Engine (J0012); and
2. The above-referenced equipment is no longer of value or use to the City; and
3. Ordinance 2963-06 establishes a procedure and methods for surplus or disposition of City-owned personal property; and
4. Based on the guidelines set forth in Section 2 of Ordinance 2963-06, a public auction is the disposition method that best meets the City's interests; and
5. The City's Purchasing Manager has reported the basis for the estimated value of the surplus property and has recommended to surplus the above-referenced vehicle and equipment by public auction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND EVERETT CITY COUNCIL THAT:

1. The City has one 1996 Emergency One Hurricane Fire Engine (J0012).
2. The disposition of this equipment at a Public Auction is hereby authorized.
