DETAILED SUMMARY STATEMENT:

In conformance with our National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Western Washington Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit, the City is required to adopt the current version of the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) Stormwater Management Manual for Western Washington.

This housekeeping code revision updates the definition of the Stormwater Management Manual in the Everett Municipal Code. The purpose of the revised definition is to specify when new versions of the manual are to become effective within the City. Accordingly, the revised definition states that, when a new manual is issued by Ecology, the new manual will take effect 90 days after issuance unless the City Engineer establishes a different effective date.

RECOMMENDATION (Exact action requested of Council):

Adopt an ordinance revising the definition of Stormwater Management Manual to include the effective date for new and revised versions.



ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance Relating to Surface and Storm Drainage, amending Ordinance No. 3528-16 (Chapter 14.28 EMC), as previously amended

WHEREAS,

- A. As set forth in Chapter 14.28 of the Everett Municipal Code, the City uses the current Department of Ecology Stormwater Management Manual for Western Washington.
- B. This Stormwater Manual is revised by the Department of Ecology from time-to-time. The purpose of this ordinance to clarify that a revised manual takes effect 90 days after issuance and that the City Engineer may establish a different effective date.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF EVERETT DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Paragraph 37 of Section 2 of Ordinance 3528-16, as amended (codified at EMC 14.28.020 (37)), is amended as follows, with underlining added:

(37) "Stormwater Management Manual" shall mean the most current Washington State Department of Ecology Stormwater Management Manual for Western Washington, along with any technical and administrative procedures established by the City Engineer which provide details for implementation of the provisions of this chapter. When the Washington State Department of Ecology issues a new or revised Stormwater Management Manual for Western Washington, the new or revised manual will for the purposes of this chapter take effect 90 days after such issuance, unless the city engineer establishes a different effective date.

Section 2. The City Clerk and the codifiers of this Ordinance are authorized to make necessary corrections to this Ordinance including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers, and any internal references.

Section 3. The City Council hereby declares that should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid for any reason, it is the intent of the City Council that it would have passed all portions of this ordinance independent of the elimination of any such portion as may be declared invalid.

Section 4. The enactment of this Ordinance shall not affect any case, proceeding, appeal or other

matter currently pending in any court or in any way modify any right or liability, civil or criminal, which may be in existence on the effective date of this Ordinance.
