Fiscal summary statement:

The subscription fee will be paid out of Fund 508 Self-Insured Health Benefits. The estimated annual cost of 98point6 services is \$11,000 per year, which is a \$4,000 per year increase over the cost of the Healthcare Management Administrator nurse line services. This contract replaces the HMA nurse line. No budget amendment will be required.

Project summary statement:

98point6 is an on-demand subscription for primary care services that will provide instant access to quality primary care via a secure mobile app. Historically, the City has offered a nurse line through Healthcare Management Administrators (HMA) that only provides nurse counseling services. 98point6 offers instant access to board-certified physicians through its secure mobile app to provide primary care services, including referrals and prescription drugs. The 98point6 service will reduce the cost of primary care medical benefits and provide an additional benefit for employees who are insured under the City's self-insured HMA medical plan. In addition, this service will augment the Vera Clinic primary care services if the clinic is unavailable. Using this service is voluntary for employees and their dependents and will be offered to City of Everett eligible employees and their dependents starting November 1, 2019.
