ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE creating a special improvement project entitled, "Citywide Safety Flashing Yellow Arrow Improvements" Fund 303, Program 116, to accumulate all costs for the improvement.

WHEREAS,

- A. The City of Everett is committed to a planned pedestrian safety program; and
- B. The City of Everett has identified the need and obtained funds to construct certain pedestrian safety improvements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF EVERETT DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. A special improvement project is hereby established as Fund 303, Program 116, entitled "Citywide Safety Flashing Yellow Arrow Improvements" to accumulate all costs for the improvement.

Section 2. Authorization is hereby given to accumulate costs and distribute payments from Fund 303, Program 116, for the improvement project.

Section 3. Authorization is hereby granted for the "Public Works Director" or "City Engineer," under direction of the Mayor, to assume full and complete responsibility for conducting all tasks and doing all things to accomplish the actions authorized in this ordinance.

Section 4. The sum of \$760,400 is hereby appropriated to Fund 303, Program 116, "Citywide Safety Flashing Yellow Arrow Improvements" as follows:

- C. This appropriation shall not lapse, but shall be carried forward from year to year until fully expended or the purpose has been accomplished or abandoned without the necessity of reappropriation.

Section 5. The City Treasurer of the City of Everett is hereby authorized to negotiate a reasonable rate of interest and obtain temporary financing to satisfy interim construction costs. Temporary financing shall be redeemed as soon as reimbursement is received.

Section 6. If any provision of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, it shall be conclusively presumed that this ordinance would have been enacted without the provision so held unconstitutional or invalid and the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected as a result of said part being unconstitutional or invalid.

Project Description: Install flashing yellow arrow left turn traffic signal phasing that operates in red when a pedestrian presses a pushbutton. Install traffic monitoring cameras and switches.

Detailed Project Description: The following work includes associated ADA and utility work as needed.

- A. Convert from protected/permitted to protected/flashing yellow arrow permitted phasing at the following intersections. Left turns will be prohibited when the pedestrian phase is on.
 1. Hewitt Ave. and Oakes Ave.
 - a. Westbound
 2. Pacific Ave. and Rucker Ave.
 - a. Westbound
 3. Hewitt Ave. and Fulton St.
 - a. Eastbound
 4. Smith Ave. and 32nd St.
 - a. Southbound
 5. 41st St. and 40th St.
 - a. Eastbound
 6. Merrill Creek Pkwy. and Glenwood Ave.
 - a. Northbound
 7. Hardeson Rd. and 75th St. SW
 - a. Northbound
 8. E Casino Rd. and Fred Meyer Driveway
 - a. Westbound
 9. Colby Ave. and 52nd St. SE
 - b. Northbound

- B. Install traffic monitoring cameras and switches at the following signalized intersections:
 1. Hewitt Ave. and Oakes Ave.
 2. Hewitt Ave. and Fulton St.
 3. Smith Ave. and 32nd St.
 4. 41st St. and 40th St.
 5. Merrill Creek Pkwy. and Glenwood Ave.
 6. Hardeson Rd. and 75th St. SW
 7. E Casino Rd. and Fred Meyer Driveway
 8. Colby Ave. and 52nd St. SE
