PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, more than 200 aerospace firms employing nearly 40,000 workers are located in and directly around Everett; and

WHEREAS, nearly half of all aerospace workers in Washington state are employed in Everett and Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, from our K-12 school system to our world-class higher education partners and apprenticeship opportunities, developing a strong, skilled future aerospace workforce is a key focus throughout Everett; and

WHEREAS, Everett has been the proud home of The Boeing Company since 1967, when the company first began building the iconic 747; and

WHEREAS, The Boeing Company's Everett facility produces the 747, 767, 777, 787 and new 777X, and is the largest building in the world (by volume); and

WHEREAS, the aerospace industry provides nearly \$4 billion in annual wages in Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, aerospace workers and their families are an integral and valued part of our community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Cassie Franklin, Mayor of the City of Everett, do hereby proclaim July 2018, as

AEROSPACE APPRECIATION MONTH

in the City of Everett to recognize the significant impact of the aerospace industry on the vitality and quality of life in and around Everett and extend sincere gratitude to the many people employed in aerospace locally.
