WHEREAS, the 747 and the Boeing Everett site have brought Presidents and other world leaders as well as hundreds of thousand of tourists to Everett; and


WHEREAS, the 747 is a transformational airplane that changed how the world traveled, enabling people and products to fly farther and faster;
