WHEREAS, the Assistance League of Everett, chartered in 1967 and a chapter of the National Assistance League formed in 1919, is an all-volunteer philanthropic organization whose projects promote the well-being and self-esteem of children, teens and adults in Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, the Operation School Bell program provides school clothes to children in need and the Graduation Award program provides aid for expenses to qualifying high school seniors in school districts within Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, Operation Self Help offers clothing vouchers for students enrolled in Operation Self Improvement, a nonprofit, two-year program for low income people returning to the workplace; and

WHEREAS, Operation Teddy Bears provides comfort to victims of sexual assault, domestic violence, hospice care, and others in times of great stress, distributed throughout Snohomish County in collaboration with Providence Regional Medical Center Everett; and


WHEREAS, the League distributes Assault Survival Kits to victims of all ages at five hospitals through the Kitty Young Auxiliary;
