Volunteers needed for Project Homeless Connect

EVERETT – Each year the United Way of Snohomish County coordinates [Project Homeless Connect](#) in Everett, a one-day event that brings together a variety of service organizations for individuals and families experiencing homelessness. This year's event will be held at Everett High School, 2416 Colby, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Thursday, July 14.

About 1,000 clients were served at the 2015 event, receiving a range of services and supplies, including haircuts, medical services, pet examinations, backpacks, toiletries, and shoes. Attendees also receive lunch, with table service provided by volunteers. [Everett Animal Services](#) provides pet examinations and cares for animals while their owners participate in the event.
