## **In the News: KIRO 7 follows up on baby born to homeless mother**

EVERETT – KIRO 7’s Gary Horcher followed up on the baby recently born to a homeless woman addicted to methamphetamines, [a story we first shared in last week’s Safe Streets update](#).

Horcher spent an afternoon with Everett Police Sgt. John Zeka and embedded social worker Kaitlyn Dowd to [get an update on how the baby is doing now](#).

Horcher met with the baby’s grandmother, who expressed her gratitude for Kaitlyn and Sgt. Zeka’s efforts. He also met the older brother of the baby’s father, who hopes to adopt the child with his fiancée. They have named the boy “Chance,” because he’s getting a second chance.
