## Police Chief to update Council Public Safety Committee about Safe Streets programs

Everett Police Chief Dan Templeman will give a Safe Streets update at tonight's Public Safety Committee meeting, at 5:30 in the City Council Chambers.

Under the Safe Streets program, the Everett Police Department has established a [Community Outreach and Enforcement Team](#), including two [embedded social workers](#). Templeman will share updates on a variety of Safe Streets programs, including:

- [PAARI \(Police Assisted Addiction and Recovery Institute\)](#)
- [Safe Streets Work Crew](#)
- the department's use of [naloxone to prevent overdoses](#)

Templeman will also talk more about the department's [crisis intervention training](#) program, which is currently holding its fourth session. Templeman made this training mandatory back in May, and all Everett officers must complete the 40 hours of the class, which is designed to help officers identify people in crisis and help deescalate situations.
