## City and Catholic Housing Services to provide update on supportive housing facility

EVERETT – Hil Kaman, Everett’s public health and safety director, will provide an update at the Sept. 28 [City Council](#) meeting on the City’s work to develop a [supportive housing facility](#) for chronically homeless individuals in our community.

The City is working with Catholic Housing Services/Catholic Community Services and other local partners to build a 70-unit apartment facility off Evergreen Way at Berkshire Drive. The building will house chronically homeless individuals, those who have been on the streets for at least a year or without housing four times in a three-year period, and who often struggle with addiction and/or mental illness. The controlled-access facility will include 24/7 on-site staff, active case management and access to treatment and other services for residents.

At the Sept. 28 meeting, Kaman will provide an overview of the project background and timeline. Representatives from Catholic Housing Services and Catholic Community Services will be on hand to share a preview of the planned facility and on-site services.
