City begins State Environmental Policy Act review process for supportive housing project

EVERETT – The Safe Streets Supportive Housing project reached an important milestone this past week. The City and Catholic Housing Services filed their land-use and short-plat applications for the project on Friday, Dec. 30, which marks the first step in the formal [State Environmental Policy Act \(SEPA\) review process](#).

Residents and business owners near the project site will receive a postcard at the end of January notifying them of the official SEPA comment period. To allow additional time for public feedback, our permit services will begin accepting comments now (via email, phone or mail), ahead of the formal comment period. The City [sent a letter](#) today to more than 1,250 residents and property owners near the project site to let them know about the opportunity to provide comment.
