CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Water Main Replacement S

Work is scheduled to begin on a water main replacement project along Rainier Avenue, between 19th Street and 23rd Street (see map on back). Reece Construction will do the work. Normal work hours will be 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The purpose of this project is to replace the old and undersized cast iron water main that serves your neighborhood. This will improve water flows and reduce the risk of a water main break.

This week the contractor will be surveying and potholing in the area to prepare for the work. Construction will begin next week, the week of May 14, starting in the 1900 block of Rainier Avenue and proceeding south on a block-by-block basis to 23th Street.

During work hours, the block where the contractor is working will be closed to traffic and parking. The contractor will notify affected residents in prior to the closures. Emergency vehicles will always have access to homes in the work area.

When installation of the pipe is complete, the existing water main will have to be shutoff to make the final connections. During this process, some homes will be temporarily without water. We will notify affected homes 24 hours prior to any outages.
