Available Kits

Water You Know (grades 2-5) - covers where your local water comes from and includes ways to save water.

What's Bugging Your Watershed (grades 3-5) - covers signs of watershed health & actions to take to help protect watersheds.

H2O & You (grades 6-8) - covers where your local water comes from and includes ways to save water.

Water Connections Day 1 (6-8) - covers how pollutants enter surface water, how wetlands act as a natural filter and ways you can help.

Water Connections Day 2 (6-8) - covers how wastewater is treated, how some pollutants impact the environment and how actions impact the environment.
