Everett Police seeking community feedback on service and priorities

Public Safety Community Survey available online through Jan. 31

EVERETT, WA – The Everett Police Department is currently updating the department’s strategic plan. All Everett community members and local stakeholders are encouraged to provide input by completing the Public Safety Community Survey, which is [available online](#) now through Jan. 31.

The department’s strategic plan identifies the department’s core values, mission, major initiatives and overall vision. The plan was [last updated in 2013](#) and does not include some current community concerns, such as addiction and street-level social issues.

“Our hope is that the survey will provide helpful insight into how our community feels about the services we provide, their safety and what they feel should be our top priorities,” said Everett Police Chief Dan Templeman. “It’s an easy five minutes out of your day that will help us shape the future of our public safety services.”

The survey results will be incorporated into the department’s updated strategic plan document, which will be available to the public this spring. The department intends to survey the community regularly moving forward to evaluate community satisfaction and priorities and guide their work.
