- Archived permit records for approved permits that have been closed or finalized.
- Note that building permit plan sets for commercial and multi-family buildings are available from 1950 to present and plans for single family residences are available from 2014 to present.

Online Permitting Portal: eTRAKiT

For best results using eTRAKiT, use Internet Explorer as your web browser.

What can be found here:

- Login to your contractor or public user account to search permits, apply for land use projects and construction permits, check the status of permits under review, and manage issued permits while in construction, including scheduling required inspections, requesting permit extensions and getting real-time inspection results. Public Users can set up an account through the website. Contractors need to contact Permit Services to create a contractor account.
