RE: UP 3691 Sewer O Utility Upgrades noise variance

Dear Ms. Roshak:

The City grants a variance to the noise ordinance, EMC 20.08, for the water utility improvements on Colby Avenue between 37th and 40th Streets. In order to minimize water supply impacts, connection work must be performed at night. This variance is granted to contractors and city crews working on this project.

The variance allows for up to 15 days of nighttime work between 10 pm and 7 am at each location during the construction window of July 1, 2020- October 30, 2020. To minimize impacts on residential and business properties, the following mitigation measures shall be in effect:

- Back-up alarms shall be directional broad band type alarms
- Whenever possible, impact noise such as jackhammering and vacuum excavation will be done during daytime hours
- No construction work will be allowed between 6 pm and 8 am on Saturdays, Sundays or federally recognized holidays. July 4th and Labor Day are within this construction window.
- Per Everett Municipal Code 20.08, the City of Everett requires notification of affected residences. Notification can be by mail or delivery.
- A copy of this variance should be on-site during the work period.

Should you wish to extend this variance please submit a renewal request prior to expiration of this variance.
