### Rover Run Racing Competition

#### ► 11am-noon — registration 10-10:50am

- Dachshund Dash** – Mostly dachshund
- Pug Chug** – Mostly pugs
- Tea Cup Trot** – approx. less than 20 lbs.
- Big Dog Derby** - more than 20 lbs.

### Pet Showcase Competition

#### ► 12:30-2pm — registration 10am-noon

- Toilet Paper Leash Obstacle Course** – If the 6 foot toilet paper leash breaks, you're out!
- Longest Tail** – From tip to rump, will your dog win? (Feathers do not count)
- Longest Ears** – We will let the judges decide....
- Catching** – Dog sits at one end of the ring and catches a tennis ball provided by the competition coordinator. Progressive throws are made from increasing distance. The winner is the dog who catches consecutively to the farthest distance.
- Musical Sit** – Handlers walk leashed dogs in a circle to music. When the music stops, handlers race to a dot and commands dogs to sit. Last dog to sit is out until three dogs remain as equal winners.
- Hurdle Jump** – Dog jumps over a fence, which will be raised in height after each successful jump. The winner is the dog who jumps the fence consecutively to the greatest height.
- Most Tricks in 45 Seconds** – Each trick must be identifiable as something new. Limited to 6 participants.
- Best Dressed Dog** – Dogs parade in costume. Owners are welcome to dress up with their dogs. Props are allowed. Multiple dogs can be entered as one entry if they fit a theme. Winner is subject to the opinion of the judges.

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## Rules

- **Leashes** – Dogs must be on a maximum 6 foot leash (except when instructed by a competition coordinator or in an off-leash play area).
- **Dangerous dogs** – Pit bulls and designated dangerous dogs may not compete in off-leash activities. No dogs in heat allowed.
- **Obey the scoop law** – Pet waste bags will be available.
- **Registration is required to enter competitions**
- **Dog handlers** – Each dog enrolled in a competition must have its own handler. For Rover Run racing competitions, dogs need two handlers, one to hold the dog at the start and one to call the dog at the finish. Volunteers may be available to assist.
- **Entry numbers** – Dog owners wear entry numbers and enter the competition area from lowest to highest number. Participants are required to be present during the entire contest and move to the prize table directly following the event.
- **Heats** – If many dogs enter a racing competition, heats will be held with the top dogs moving on.
- **Prizes** –prizes will be awarded for all competitions.

## Community Dog Walk

- Congregate with your dog in the competition area at 10:10
- The route is out and back along the Langus River, going north along the dike—1.2 miles total
- Water and dog treats at the beginning and the end of the walk – Strut your Mutt!
