City accepting applications for lodging tax grants Completed applications due Wednesday, Feb. 1

EVERETT – The City of Everett is accepting Hotel Motel Tax Fund applications until 5 p.m., Wednesday, Feb. 1, from public and non-profit agencies for projects that assist in tourism development and promotion.

The grant program is made possible through taxes imposed on hotel and motel room rentals in the City of Everett. Grants funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to eligible applicants who can demonstrate ability to complete projects by Dec. 31, 2017.
